The Mary W. and Nicholas S. Willson Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements:

- Adult Undergraduate Student
- Financial Need
- Potential to Succeed
- **Typed essay, no more than one page, stating why you would like to be considered for the Scholarship.**

Criteria for Yearly Renewal:

- In Good Academic Standing
- Continued Financial Need
- Student must provide *Annual Letter of Progress*

Awarded for One Year with Annual Renewal Based on Eligibility Status.

Philosophy:

The Mary W. and Nicholas S. Willson Scholarship (Willson Scholarship) fund was developed to create an opportunity for an adult undergraduate student by providing funds for expenses associated with the College's academic program. Often adult undergraduate students are unable to continue or complete their education due to financial hardships. This scholarship can help with tuition, books, professional fees, technology requirements, and other incidentals as deemed appropriate. The objective of the Willson Scholarship is to reduce these financial challenges to enable students to reach their goal.

A total of up to \$6,000 per academic year may be awarded to a qualifying student and/or students. The amount of the award will be determined according to individual need. Student and/or students are eligible to renew the scholarship upon meeting the designated criteria stated above. Scholarship is to be used for expenses related to achieving an education. A select panel of evaluators will determine candidates. Mary Anne Willson is to be notified and updated annually as to the distribution of funds.
